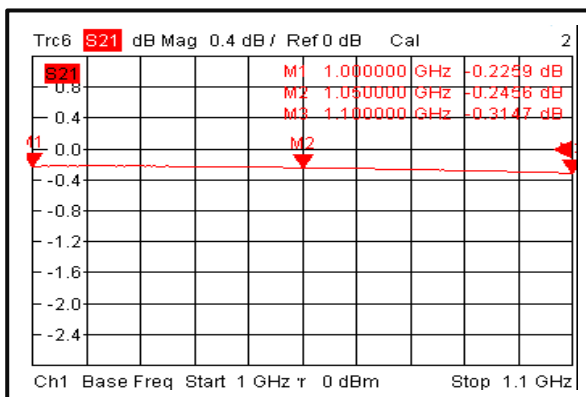

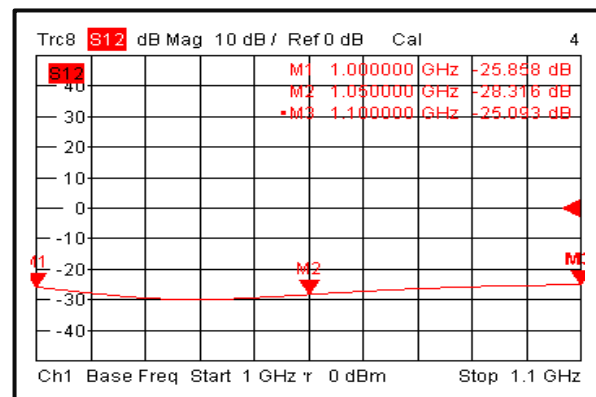

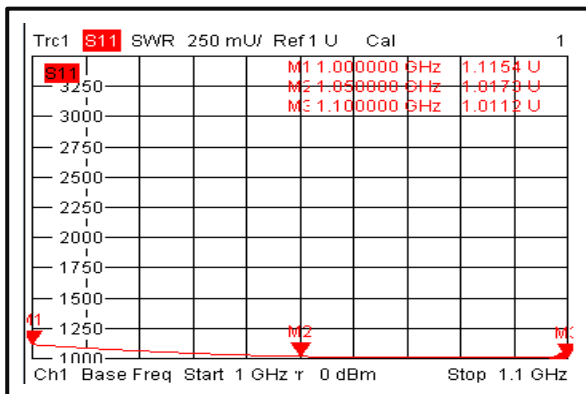
Insertion Loss



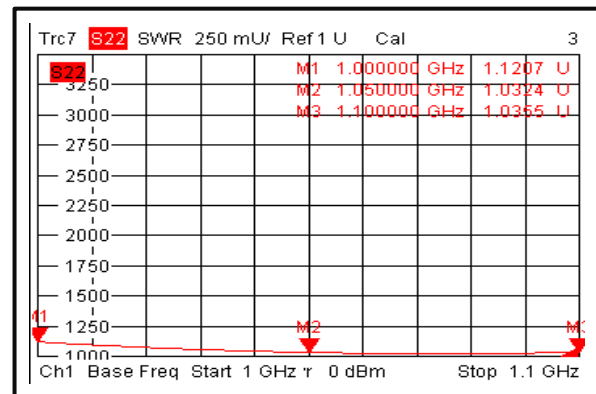
Isolation



VSWR 1



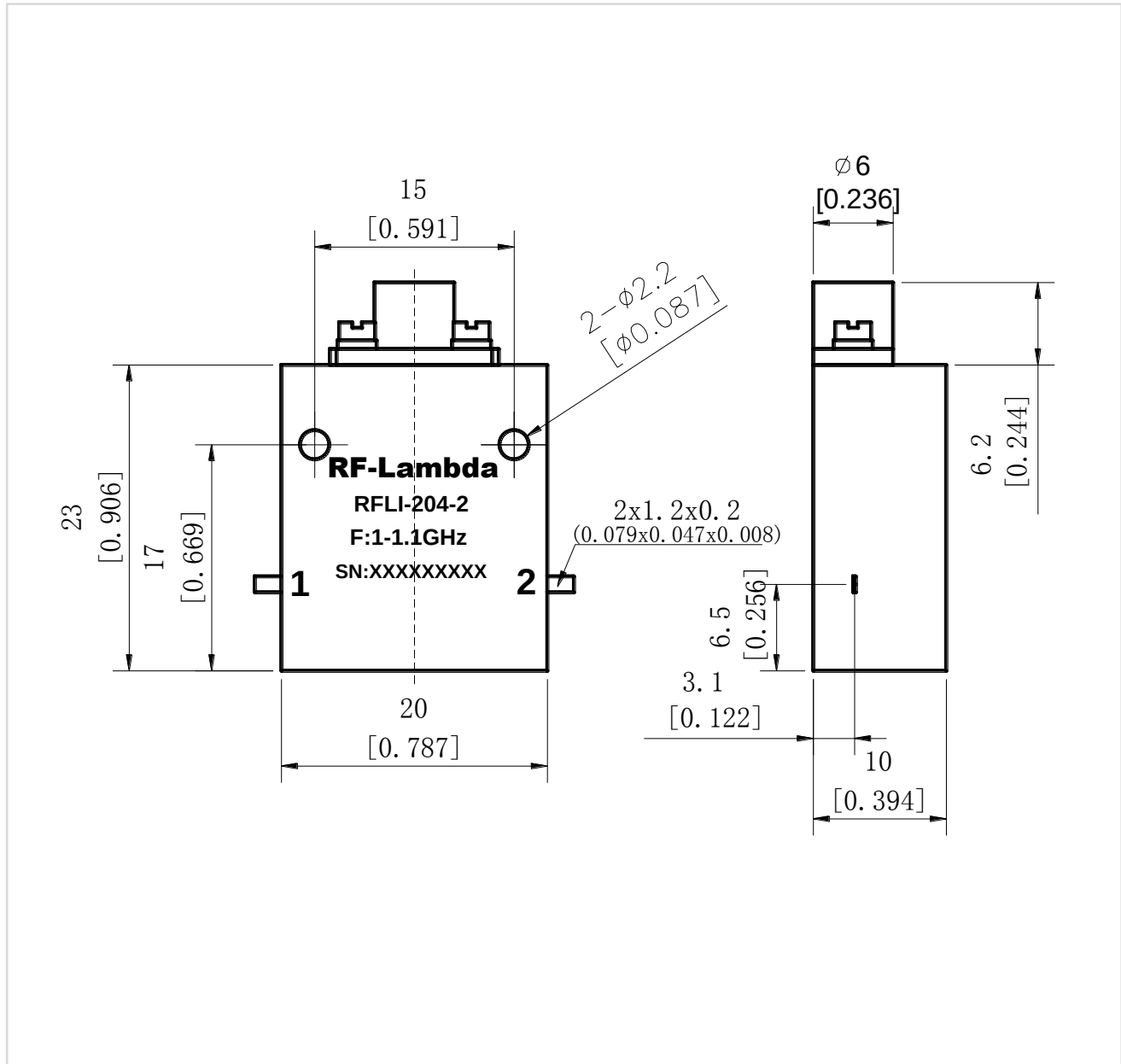
VSWR2
