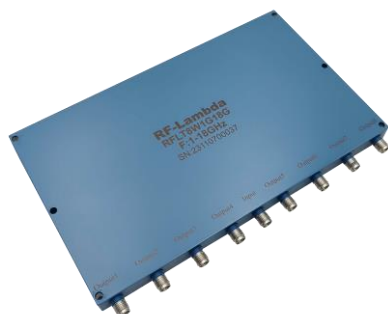


Coaxial 30W 0° 8-Way Power Divider 1GHz-18GHz

RFLT8W1G18G is an 8-way power divider with a frequency range of 1 to 18GHz.

The forward power rating of this power divider is 30W. The insertion loss is 3.0dB with a typical isolation of 18dB.

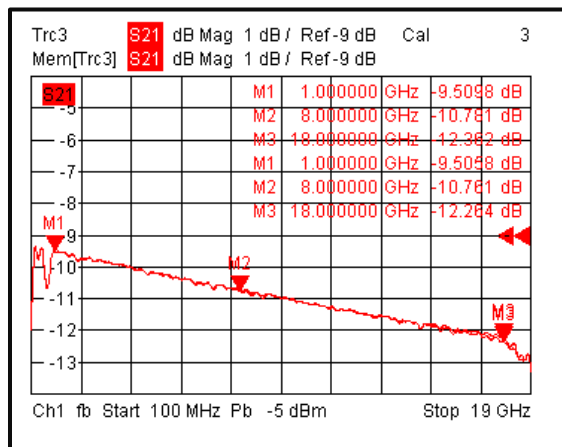

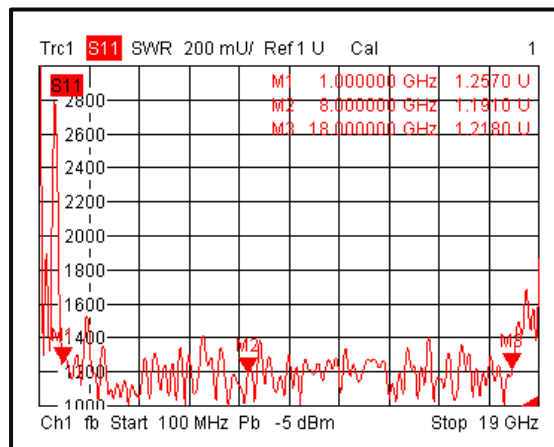

Typical Performance Plots

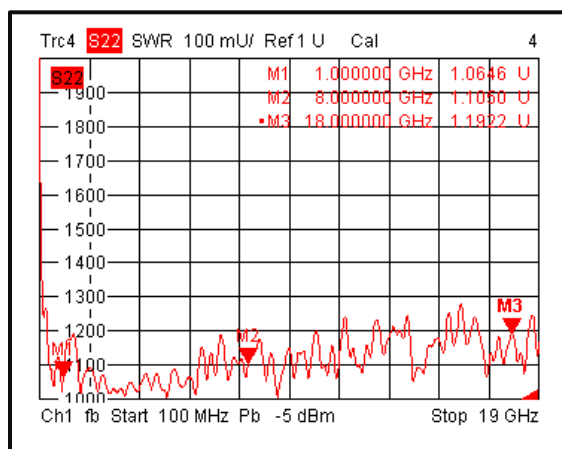
Loss & Amplitude Imbalance



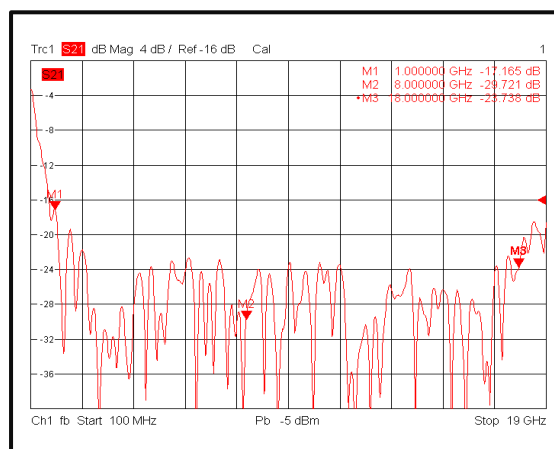
Input VSWR



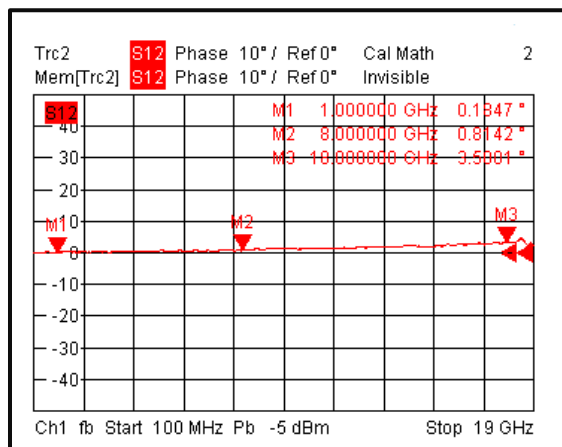
Output VSWR



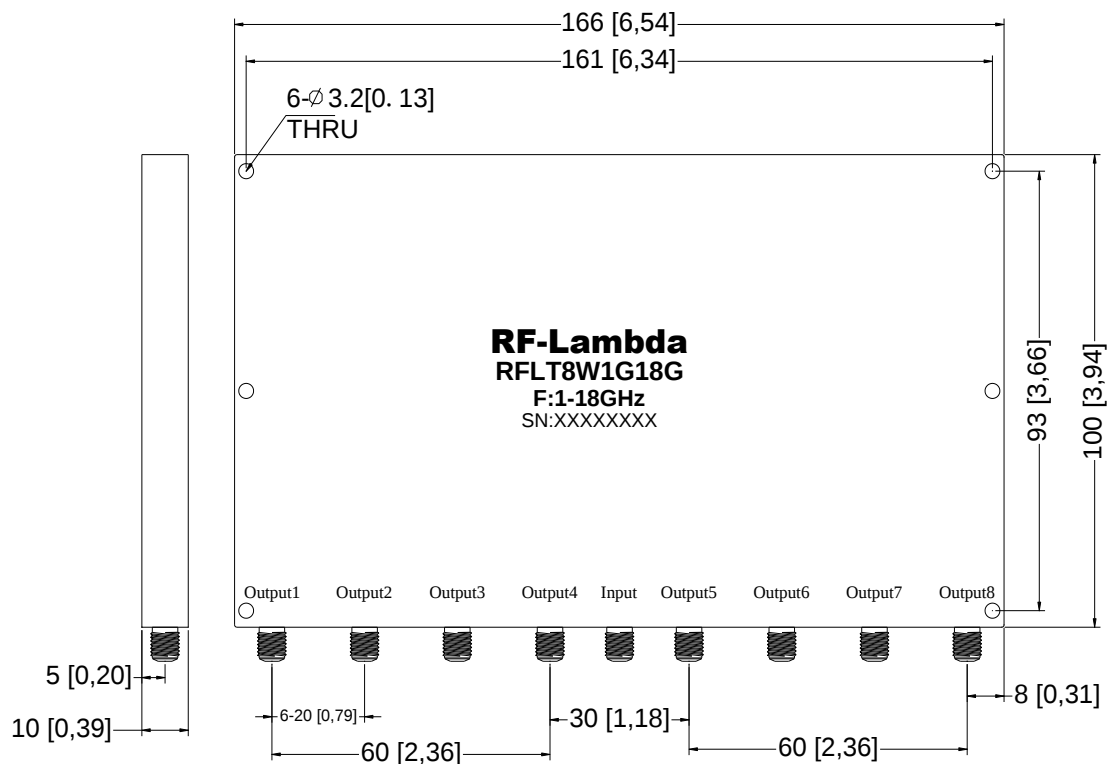
Isolation



Phase Imbalance

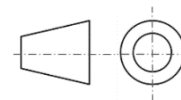
